ORDER:

In the Government order read above, orders were issued to establish Emergency Department in 25 Government Medical College Hospitals with additional posts of Professor, Associate Professor, Assistant Professor and ED Secretary at a total cost of Rs.10.97 Crores per annum.

2. In line of the above, the Hon'ble Minister for Health and Family Welfare has made the following Announcement in the floor of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly during the Assembly Session 2021-2022, Demand No.19:-

(Announcement No.87):

“அதிநவீன அவசர சிகிச்சைத்துறை (Emergency Department) 11 புதிய மருத்துவக் கல்லூரி மருத்துவமனைகளில் நிறுவப்படும்.”

3. Based on the above, the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has stated that the National Medical Commission (NMC) has granted Letter of Permission to admit students for M.B.B.S. Course during the academic year 2021-2022 in all the 11 Medical College Hospitals. Since the Emergency Department is mandatory in all Medical College Hospitals from the year 2022-2023 and to improve the Emergency Care Services, as requested by the Director of Medical Education and Research, it is proposed to create with dedicated faculties as per the following National Medical Commission Norms:-

The posts required for Emergency Department should be teaching posts on par with all other Departments sanctioned in Medical College Hospitals. Only then the Medical Officers working in ED will be considered as faculty in concerned specialty / ED and they can be having the further promotion such as Assistant Professor / Associate Professor / Professor in concerned department / ED. As per NMC norms, the ED should have 9 Senior Resident posts. There are 6 posts of Causality Medical Officer (CMO) which have already been created in the 11 new Medical College Hospitals and its name may be re-designated as Senior Resident in Emergency Department. Therefore, it is requested to create the remaining 3 posts of Senior Resident in Emergency Department.

4. Thus the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has proposed to sanction the following posts to the Emergency Department in 11 New Medical College Hospitals.

6. The Director of Medical Education has stated that 199 posts have been identified in regular time scale of pay under the control of Director of Medical Education and Research for surrender for creation of post to 11 New Government Medical College and Hospital as detailed in Annexure-III.

7. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has further stated that the above proposal was approved by the State Empowered Committee and hence requested the Government for the Establishment of Emergency Department in 11 New Medical College Hospitals.

8. The Government after careful consideration of the proposal of the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program have decided to accept the same and accordingly issue the following orders subject to surrender of equivalent posts.

- i. The Director of Medical Education and Research is permitted to establish Emergency Department at 11 New Government Medical College Hospitals listed in the annexure I to this order.
- ii. Sanction is accorded for the creation of the posts to the Emergency Department in 11 New Medical College Hospitals as follows:-

The Job functions, Mode of appointment, etc., should be follow the orders already issued in G.O.(Ms) No.425, Health and Family Welfare (EAPI-1) Department, dated 22.10.2020 which is regarding to establish Emergency Department in 25 Government Medical College Hospitals.

- iii. Sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs.9,07,71,252/- (Rupees nine crore seven lakh seventy one thousand two hundred and fifty two only) towards the salary of regular time scale pay posts sanctioned for the Establishment of Emergency Department in 11 New Medical College Hospitals.
- iv. Sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs.18,48,000/- (Rupees eighteen lakh forty eight thousand only) towards the salary of Contract posts sanctioned for the Establishment of Emergency Department in 11 New Medical College Hospitals.
- v. The Director of Medical Education and Research is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned at para 8(iii) and (iv) above.
- vi. During the Project Period, the above may be funded under Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program. After the Project Period, it may be booked under State Government as it is mandatory under NMC Guidelines.
- vii. A separate account to be maintained exclusively for Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program funds in Directorates and facilities involved which should be operated by joint signatory.

11. Necessary funds of Rs.9,26,19,252/- will be provided in Revised Estimate/ Final Modified Appropriation 2023-2024. Pending provision of such funds, the Director of Medical Education and Research is authorized to draw and disburse the above sanctioned amount. However, this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislative by Specific Inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2023-2024. The Director of Medical Education and Research is also requested to include this expenditure while sending the budget proposals for Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2023-2024 and also send draft explanatory notes for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2023-2024 to Government in Finance (BG-I/Health-II) Department at an appropriate time without fail.
