**ABSTRACT**

**ORDER:**

In the Government Order first read above, orders were issued restructuring the posts of Health Officer and Deputy Director of Health Services as Health Officer, Senior Health Officer, Deputy Director of Health Services Grade II and Deputy Director of Health Services Grade I, so as to enable the incumbents, to get promotions to the higher level posts.

2. In the Government Order second read above, the Government have amended the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Public Health Services with the concurrence of the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission.

3. In the Government order third read above, Government have streamlined the teaching posts sanctioned in Government Medical Colleges and Hospitals under the control of Director of Medical Education in various Government orders according to the norms of the Medical Council of India and patient care requirements.

4. In the letter fourth read above, the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has stated that the Department of Public Health and Preventive Medicine formed during 1923 is engaged in protecting and promoting the health of the people in Tamil Nadu. Tamil Nadu Public Health Service was given statutory status in the year 1939. The Department of Public Health and Preventive Medicine is administered by officers of Tamil Nadu Public Health Service, a dedicated non-practicing cadre which do not do private practice from the date of inception into service with Post Graduate qualification in Public Health recognized by the Medical Council of India. They have achieved remarkable success in eradication, elimination and control of infectious diseases such as Smallpox, Guinea worm, Polio and Yaws.

The Tamil Nadu Public Health Service officials implement Public Health programs, projects funded by Government of India and external agencies and also look after various Acts relating to Public Health side.

5. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has stated that in the earlier occasions, no eligible candidates were available in the Department of Community Medicine to take the classes to the medical students. Hence, to fulfill the MCI norms the posts sanctioned under Directorate of Public Health and Preventive Medicine were utilised in the Government Medical Colleges as Tutor/ Assistant Professor / Associate Professor / Professor in Community Medicine department and therefore, the said posts are filled up with the Health Officer and Deputy Director of Health Services now Deputy Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine (Grade II) (Category-2C). As per the norms of Medical Council of India and patient care requirements the sanctioned teaching posts viz. Professor, Associate Professor, Assistant Professor, Tutor and Senior Resident and Junior Resident have been streamlined college wise and department wise vide G.O. third read above. Henceforth, the posts of Assistant Professor / Professor / Associate Professor / Reader in Community Medicine were filled up with Medical Officers from Tamil Nadu Medical Services.

6. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has further stated that in the present scenario, the services of Tamil Nadu Public Health Service Officers deputed to the medical colleges were utilized in prevention and control of outbreaks of natural calamities like Floods, cyclones and also during the large mass gatherings like Mahamaham and other religious festivals.

7. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has stated the following:

- In the 14 corporations 3 posts in the cadre of Deputy Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine (Grade II) (Category 2C) have been sanctioned at Coimbatore, Madurai and Erode Corporations.
- In Coimbatore and Madurai one more additional post has been sanctioned in the cadre of Health Officer
- In the Corporations of Hosur and Avadi no post has been sanctioned in any cadre i.e., Health Officer, Senior Health Officer and Deputy Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine Grade II.
- In the remaining 9 Corporations namely Dindigul, Nagercoil, Salem, Thanjavur, Thoothukudi, Tirunelveli, Tiruppur, Tiruchirappalli and Vellore the post of Senior Health Officer have been sanctioned.

8. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has stated the following to maintain uniformity in the cadre of post among the Corporations and to render effective public health service in rapidly urbanizing cities which caters vulnerable groups:-

- ❖ the post of Deputy Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine (Grade II) (Category 2C) may be sanctioned to all the remaining 11 Corporations, for which the said post allotted to Government Medical Colleges (Total 17 post) may be allotted to these Corporations.
- ❖ the post of Senior Health Officer sanctioned to the 9 Corporations may be re-allotted for Special Grade Municipalities.

- ❖ in respect of 17 Special Grade Municipalities, 4 municipalities are having the post of Health Officer and 6 municipalities are having the post of Senior Health Officer. For the remaining 7 municipalities there is no post in the cadre of Health Officer or Senior Health Officer has been sanctioned so far. Among the 17 Special Grade Municipalities, 6 Municipalities are having the post of Senior Health Officer and for the remaining 11 special grade Municipalities the posts of Senior Health Officer has to be sanctioned to maintain the uniformity. For which the posts of Senior Health Officer allotted to 9 Corporations and 1 post allotted to Epidemiological Unit, Madras Medical College and 1 posts allotted as Health Educator, Research Cum Action Project, Thanjavur may be allotted.
- ❖ The 4 posts of Health Officer allotted to the Special Grade municipalities namely Cuddalore, Karaikudi, Rajapalayam and Thiruvannamalai may be re-allotted to other Municipalities where there is no sanctioned post of Health Officer.

9. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine also stated that apart from Special Grade Municipalities, the Municipalities have been classified as Selection Grade Municipalities, Grade-I Municipalities and Grade-II Municipalities. As of now there are 104 Municipalities (Selection Grade-28, Grade I-32, Grade II-44) available. Among the 104 municipalities the Government have sanctioned 19 posts alone in the cadre of Health Officer, the remaining 85 Municipalities, the posts of Health Officer is not sanctioned. The Government has created the above said municipalities based on the increase of population from time to time. Though the Government has created the above said municipalities based on the increase of population and due to non-creation of the post of Health Officer, no supervision for Public Health Services including prevention of spread of communicable as well as control and treatment of Non-communicable diseases is carried out in the community. Due to the above said absence nowadays the Government has strived to control the spread of pandemic COVID-19. Hence, it is mandatory to sanction the post of Health Officer in the municipalities. In addition to the posts of Health Officer allotted to 4 special grade municipalities (Rajapalayam, Karaikudi, Tiruvannamalai, Cuddalore), the 13 posts of Health Officer allotted to the Government Medical Colleges may be allotted to the municipalities. The 17 municipalities are selected by considering the morbidity pattern, previous outbreaks, population and District Head-quarters status.

10. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has requested the Government to pass suitable orders on the following:

- i. The 16 posts of Deputy Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine (Grade II) (Category 2C) sanctioned to Community Medicine Department in Government Medical Colleges may be reorganized and allotted to the 12 Corporations, 4 different programmes at Office of the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine
- ii. The posts of Senior Health Officers may be reorganized and allotted to the Special grade Municipalities.
- iii. The posts of Health Officers may be reorganized and allotted to the Selection Grade / Grade 1/ Grade 2 Municipalities.
- iv. In-incorporation the above points and the posts sanctioned in G.O (Ms) No.12, Health and Family Welfare Department, dated 20.01.2010 may be reorganized.

11. It is pertinent to mention that the 29 posts earmarked to Community Medicine department of Government Medical Colleges are among the 162 posts of Tamil Nadu Public Health Services as per G.O (Ms) No.12, Health and Family Welfare (L2) Department, dated 20.01.2010 remained independent of the consolidated posts sanctioned to the Directorate of Medical Education institutions as per G.O (4D) No.2, Health and Family Welfare (A1) Department, dated 15.02.2019. Of the 29 posts, 9 posts are permanent in nature and for the remaining 20 posts further continuance has been issued in the G.O (D) No.723, Health and Family Welfare Department, dated 31.07.2004, G.O(D) No.397, Health and Family Welfare Department, dated 30.05.2005 and in Letter No.1562/N1/2022-21, Health and Family Welfare (N1) Department, dated 18.11.2022. Pay authorisation has been issued to the above said posts till November 2022 and all the 29 posts have been occupied till recently i.e., live posts.

12. As per the norms fixed by Medical Council of India, the teaching posts in the Directorate of Medical Education department-wise and College-wise has been streamlined vide G.O.(4D) No.2 Health and Family Welfare (A1) Department, dated 15.02.2019. A total of 250 posts in the cadre of Professor (29), Associate Professor (43), Assistant Professor (121) and Tutor (57) have been sanctioned in the Community Medicine Department of Government Medical Colleges as per the undergraduate sanctioned strength.

13. In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 57 of the National Medical Commission Act, 2019 (30 of 2019); the National Medical Commission made the following regulations namely the 'Minimum requirements for Annual M.B.B.S., Admissions Regulations, 2020' and fixed the requirement of staff for Department of Community Medicine in a Medical College for 100 admissions.

14. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has stated that as per the 'Minimum requirements for Annual M.B.B.S. Admissions Regulations, 2020' framed based on the revised National Medical Commission norms, 2 Medical Officers need to be there. As the Medical officer deployed by Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine in these Training Centres can be shown in National Medical Commission, the 22 posts sanctioned to Community Medicine Department may be re-deployed to Urban Local bodies / Programmes.

15. The Government after careful examination have decided to accept the proposal of the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine and issue the following orders:

- 1) The Public Health cadre post in the Community Medicine Department of Government Medical Colleges to Urban Local bodies / Programmes are redistributed as follows:
