ORDER:

In the Government order first read above, Government have accorded administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.338.76 crore and released a sum of Rs. 100.00 crore for the year 2019 - 2020 for the construction works of Government Medical College and Hospital Buildings for 150 MBBS students at Namakkal in Namakkal District.

2. In the letters second read above, the Director of Medical Education has stated that, based on the per capita consumption the following water requirement is necessary for effective function of Hospital, College and Residential Buildings of the newly established Government Medical College, at Namakkal: -

In the letter third read above, the Engineer in Chief and Chief Engineer (Buildings) has stated that the average yield from the existing borewells in the campus is only 6000 litre /one borewell per day. Hence from the existing 7 borewells, 42000 litres of water will be available daily during normal seasons. However, during summer season yield from the borewells is reduced to hardly 2000 litres/one borewell per day which is far below the requirement of 1.4 MLD of water for the New Medical College and Hospital Buildings. Further, the Executive Engineer, Public Works Department., Ground Water Division, Salem has stated that Siluvampatti village and its surrounding area the main soil type is identified as red soil and it is followed by crystalline rocks. The Ground Water potential and permeability will be in the range from 9-25 m²/day and 0.26-1.63 m/day at low to moderate range. Hence it is very much essential to provide water supply to the New Medical College and Hospital under Combined Water Supply (CWS) by TWAD Board and accordingly the online application was submitted by the Dean cum special Officer to the Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board (TWAD). The water supply under Combined Water Supply (CWS) fulfilling the requirement of 1.40 MLD of water.

4. The Director of Medical Education has furnished the estimated cost towards providing 1.40 MLD water supply connections to Government Medical College in Namakkal from existing sump in Musiri under Combined Water Supply Scheme (CWSS) towards the following items and Break up details for the Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board (TWAD) water supply:

- i. Total quantity required 1400-KLD (1.40 MLD)
- ii. Water Tariff
- iii. 3 Months advance water charges (1400x(365/4) x30)
- iv. 3 Months water charges as caution deposit (1400x (365/4) x30)
- v. Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board (TWAD) Estimate cost (infrastructure pipeline & pump set cost) upto delivery point at Namakkal Government Medical College, Campus

Based on the above estimates received from Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board (TWAD) Namakkal and Public Works Department (PWD), Salem, Dean, Government Medical College Hospital, Namakkal has requested to consider the sanction of Rs.7,13,95,000/- towards, providing 1.40 MLD water supply connection to Government Medical College in Namakkal from existing sump in Musiri under Combined Water Supply Scheme (CWSS).

5. The Director of Medical Education has therefore requested the Government

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Government Medical College Hospital Buildings, Institution Buildings and Residential Buildings, Namakkal.

6. The Government have examined the proposal of the Director of Medical Education in detail and decided to accept it. Accordingly, the Government hereby accord administrative and financial sanction for the sum of Rs.7,13,95,000/- (Rupees Seven crore thirteen lakhs and ninety five thousand only) for providing 1.40 MLD water supply arrangements for newly established Government Medical College Hospital, Namakkal.

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para -6 above shall be debited to the following head of Account:-

"2210 Medical and Public Health – 01 Urban Health Services – Allopathy – 110 Hospital and Dispensaries – State's Expenditure – MS Government Medical College Hospital, Namakkal – 306 Rent, Rates and Taxes – 03 Water Charges"

8. Necessary funds of Rs. 7,13,95,000/- will be provided in RE / FMA 2022-2023. Pending provision of such funds in RE / FMA 2022-2023, the Director of Medical Education is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned above. However, this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislature by specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2022-2023. The Director of Medical Education is requested to include the amount sanctioned above while sending the budget proposals for RE / FMA 2022-2023 and also send necessary draft explanatory notes for inclusion of this expenditure in the supplementary estimates 2022-2023 to Government in Finance (Health-II/BG-I) Department without fail.

9. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O. No. 46810 / Health-II / 2022, dated 31.10.2022 and ASL No. 1654 (One thousand Six hundred and Fifty Four) (IFHRMS ASL No. 2022101654).
