ORDER :

In the Government Order second read above, the Foreign Medical Graduates who were aspiring to do Compulsory Medical Rotatory Internship in Government Medical Colleges of this State were prescribed to pay the facilitation fee as follows:-

(i)	Facilitation / processing Fee for Issue of No Objection Certificate	Rs.3,54,000/- Including GST payable to Tamil Nadu Dr.MGR Medical University.
(ii)	Facilitation Fees to Government Side	Rs.2,00,000/- payable (Rs.1,00,000/- to respective Medical College account and Rs.1,00,000/-) to Government account through respective Medical Colleges

2. The Foreign Medical Graduates qualified in Foreign Medical Graduate Examination conducted by National Medical Commission and provisionally registered



with Tamil Nadu State Medical Council are admitted to pursue Compulsory Medical Rotatory Internship following norms of National Medical Commission, as per the regulations mandated periodically to do internship for 12 months in the Tamil Nadu State Medical Colleges in a manner prescribed by Government from time to time. Later, the powers to allocate the Compulsory Medical Rotatory Internship training to such Foreign Medical Graduates / Indian Medical Graduates of other State to do Compulsory Medical Rotatory internship have been delegated to Director of Medical Education vide the Government order third read above.

3. The National Medical Commission (NMC) by their notification, dated 18.11.2021 as read fifth above, among others, by the National Medical Commission (CRMI) Regulations, 2001, in Schedule IV, Sec 3 (a) mandates that all Under Graduate medical interns shall be paid stipend as fixed by the appropriate authority applicable to the Institution / University of the State. Further, as per Regulation 4(a)(ii) and clause 2 (iii) of Schedule-I of the National Medical Commission (Foreign Medical Graduates) Regulation 2021 as notified in Government of India Gazette dated 18.11.2021, the Foreign Medical Graduates will be eligible to be granted with permanent Registration in India; only after having undergone Medical Internship for a minimum duration of 12 months in the same foreign Medical Institution in continuation of the 54 months of Foreign Medical Degree and the same cannot be as part in India or in any country other than country from where the primary medical qualification is obtained. Further in addition they need to do 12 months internship in India.

4. Pursuant to the repeated requests received from parents / students and as per the decision arrived in the meeting held on 22.10.2021 with all stakeholder Departments, the Tamil Nadu M.G.R. Medical University, has resolved to reduce the processing fee of Rs.3,54,000/- hitherto levied by Tamil Nadu Dr.M.G.R. Medical University to that of Rs.25,000/- + 18% GST per student. Accordingly formal orders were issued by the Tamil Nadu Dr.M.G.R. Medical University to implement the same with effect from February 2022.

5. In parallel, requests were received in Government from Foreign Medical Graduates / Compulsory Medical Rotatory Internship aspiring students and their parents seeking to reduce the infrastructure and amenities charges of Rs.2,00,000/- levied to be paid to Government account and also seeking to sanction stipend to Foreign Medical Graduates / Indian Medical Graduates pursuing Compulsory Medical Rotatory Internship in State Government Medical Colleges on par with internship of State Medical Colleges. The Government have examined the issue in detail in the light of the proposal of the Director of Medical Education recommending sanctioning stipend considering the present position. Institutions need to periodically upgrade infrastructure to cater to the increased training needs of students.

6. After the due examination of the issue the Government do hereby direct,

(i) to sanction stipend to Foreign Medical Graduates / Indian Medical Graduates of other State pursuing Compulsory Medical Rotatory Internship in the Tamil Nadu State Medical Colleges on par with internee of State Medical Colleges during the period of their 12 months Compulsory Medical Rotatory Internship training as per the orders issued in the Government order 4th read above i.e. all the Foreign Medical Graduates / Indian Medical Graduates pursuing

① Compulsory Medical Rotatory Internship shall be paid with the stipend at the rate of Rs.25,750/- per month during the year 2022-2023. There will be an automatic 3% annual increase in subsequent years for Foreign Medical Graduates similar to the regular Compulsory Medical Rotatory Internships; and

② (ii) that the orders issued vide the Government order second read above prescribing the infrastructure and amenities charges payable by the Foreign Medical Graduates / Indian Medical Graduates of other State for admission to Compulsory Medical Rotatory Internship in State Medical Colleges to be continued to improve and upgrade the infrastructure of the institutions, to meet the needs of higher students strength. If the aspiring Compulsory Medical Rotatory Internship trainee is not able to pay the infrastructure and amenities charges of Rs.2,00,000/- upfront, then the infrastructure and amenities charges payable as above shall be deducted from their stipend in 12 instalments, collected and remitted to the relevant accounts (i.e. Rs.17,000/- in first 11 months each and Rs.13,000/- in the 12th month).

7. The Director of Medical Education shall take immediate action to implement the orders above through the Deans of respective Medical Colleges. The expenditure towards sanction of stipend to the Foreign Medical Graduates / Indian Medical Graduates with reference to the orders above, shall be met out from the existing stipend head of account. The Director of Medical Education shall also workout the additional requirement of funds for the financial year 2022-2023 at once and send suitable proposal for sanction of additional funds appropriately. Further, the Director of Medical Education shall, while allowing the concession of the payment of infrastructure and amenities charges of Rs. 2,00,000/-, ensure receipt of an undertaking from the student and parents concerned to the extent of condition that they shall duly agree to the recovery / reduction of stipend to compensate the EMIs allowed against the payment of infrastructure and amenities charges. The Director of Medical Education shall also ensure the remittance of applicable charges to Government account periodically as is being followed now.

8. The orders issued above shall take prospective effect from the date of issue of this Government order and no claim of sanction of stipend for the previous / completed period shall be entertained.
